HOW DO I GET TICKETS?



Tickets are on sale at The Mount Baker Theatre ticketing office. You can purchase them in person or online (extra fee charged by MBT when purchased online). It is not general admission so we recommend getting tickets right away so you can get a good seat to watch your dancer!



WHERE DOES MY DANCER GO FOR DRESS REHEARSAL?

Dancers should be dropped off at the back alley door at The Mount Baker Theatre **in FULL costume** with **no personal belongings** (teachers will direct them on where to go backstage)

**Parents if you are staying to watch you will need to go through backstage to get to the main theater (MBT front doors will be locked)

WHEN DOES MY DANCER HAVE DRESS REHEARSAL?

If your dancer ONLY performs on Friday or their class performs in all three shows dress rehearsal is:

FRIDAY, JUNE 21st- Please arrive at 1:00pm
Rehearsal is from 1:30-4pm

If your dancer is ONLY on Saturday dress rehearsal is:

SATURDAY, JUNE 22nd- Please arrive at 1:00pm
Rehearsal is from 1:30-2:30

If your dancer is ONLY on Sunday dress rehearsal is:

SATURDAY, JUNE 22nd- Please arrive at 2:30pm
Rehearsal is from 3-4

****Parents can STAY and watch the rehearsal****

HOW DO I KNOW WHEN MY DANCER PERFORMS?

Performance days are listed in the costume book at the studio or you can access the “Dancer Information” on the Year End Production page on our website.

WHAT TIME ARE THE PERFORMANCES?

FRIDAY, JUNE 21st @ 7 pm (dancers arrive at 6:30pm)

SATURDAY, JUNE 22nd @ 7pm (dancers arrive at 6:30pm)

SUNDAY, JUNE 24th @ 2 pm (dancers arrive at 1:30 pm)

WHERE DOES MY DANCER GO FOR THE PERFORMANCE?

All dancers should be dropped off at the back alley door

IN FULL COSTUME.

Parents will not be able to come backstage at this time unless they are a parent volunteer.

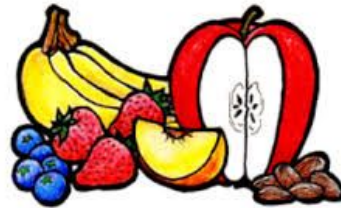
Parents should enter the theater at the main doors.

Friday & Saturday the main doors open at 6pm, house opens at 6:30pm.

Sunday main doors open at 1pm, house opens at 1:30pm.

WHAT SHOULD MY DANCER BRING TO THE PERFORMANCE?

Dancers should bring a disposable water bottle and disposable snack (if needed). If they are in multiple dances they should have their other costume(s) and appropriate shoes and tights for each costume. If your dancer is in the Walton Theatre they should not bring any personal items.



WHAT IS MY LITTLE DANCER DOING DURING THE SHOW?

All younger dancers are in the Walton Theater during the performance. There are parent volunteers as well as teachers in the Walton room at all times. The show is streamed on a big screen so they are able to watch it live, and coloring books are provided.



WHEN IS MY DANCER FINISHED PERFORMING?

If your dancer is only in the first half of the show and they are in the “Crocodile” dance, they will be brought out at the start of intermission and handed to you from the stage.

Dancers in the first and/or second half of the show that are in the Walton Room, and are not leaving the stage at intermission, should be picked up at the main doors of the Walton Room in the lobby. Please only send ONE person to pick up the dancer to avoid blocking the exit doors. Technique dancers will be able to come out to the lobby through the house, or they can get picked up at the back alley doors.

IS THERE A VIDEO OF THE PERFORMANCE?
